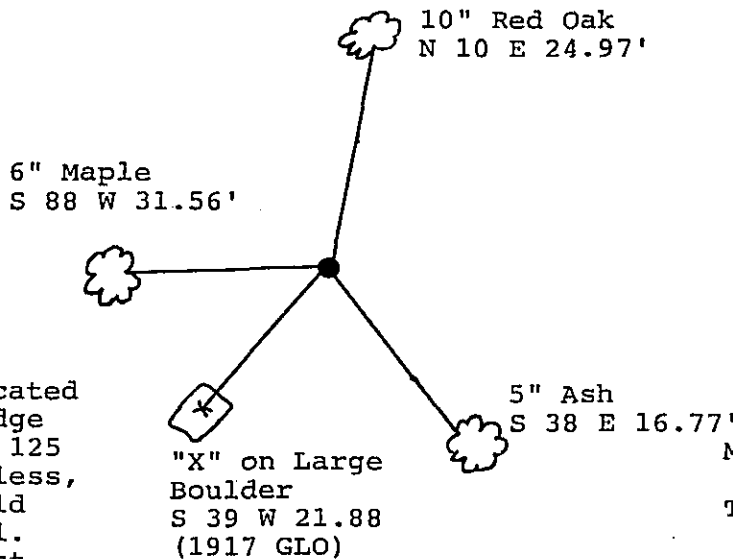
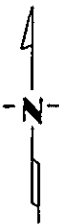

DATE Cap in place of broken monument.

All distances are horizontal to nail in side of tree.



Monument is located at Northerly edge of small swamp 125 feet, more or less, Northerly of old East-West Trail. 8 foot sign post South 5.0 feet.

East Quarter Corner Section 18, Township 141
North, Range 30 West, Cass County, Minnesota

1873 P. H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, originally established this corner position while subdividing Township 141 North, Range 30 West. The notes indicate a wood post was set to mark the corner position and the following witnesses: a 10 inch Red Oak North 87 degrees East a distance of 12 links; and a 6 inch Red Oak South 86 degrees West a distance of 18 links.

1917 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner proportionally between the Northeast and the Southeast Corners of said Section 18. A 1 inch by 36 inch iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark this corner. Placed a mound of stone with a 2 foot base, 1 and 1/2 feet high west of corner; "x" on rock 6 feet by 6 feet by 4 feet South 36 and 3/4 degrees West a distance of 33 links.

1986 U.S. Forest Service crews set an aerial target in the vicinity of this corner for the search and establishment of the true corner position. The target having coordinate values through the use of GPS on the Chippewa South Boundary Project Cadastral Survey U.S. Project Number 53-6392-8-219. This target allowed for the search and location of this corner.

1988 on July 19 a Landecker-Stevenson & Associates crew searched from target Number 24. The following information was found: a brass cap monument up 16 inches, rusted. Top broke off when wiggled. Set a 2 inch by 48 inch iron pipe with brass cap and plastic base. Corner on Northerly edge of small swamp; 125 feet, more or less, Northerly of old East-West trail; 1918 "x" on rock South 39 degrees West a distance of 21.88 feet. Set a 8 foot signpost South 5.0 feet, with sign 54-9; a 5 inch Ash South 38 degrees East a distance of 16.77 feet; a 6 inch Maple South 88 degrees West a distance of 31.56 feet; and a 10 inch Red Oak North 10 degrees East a distance of 24.97 feet.

1988 on July 26 a Landecker-Stevenson & Associates crew visited the corner. They did a solar observation and tied corner to target. (Book 3, Page 43)
