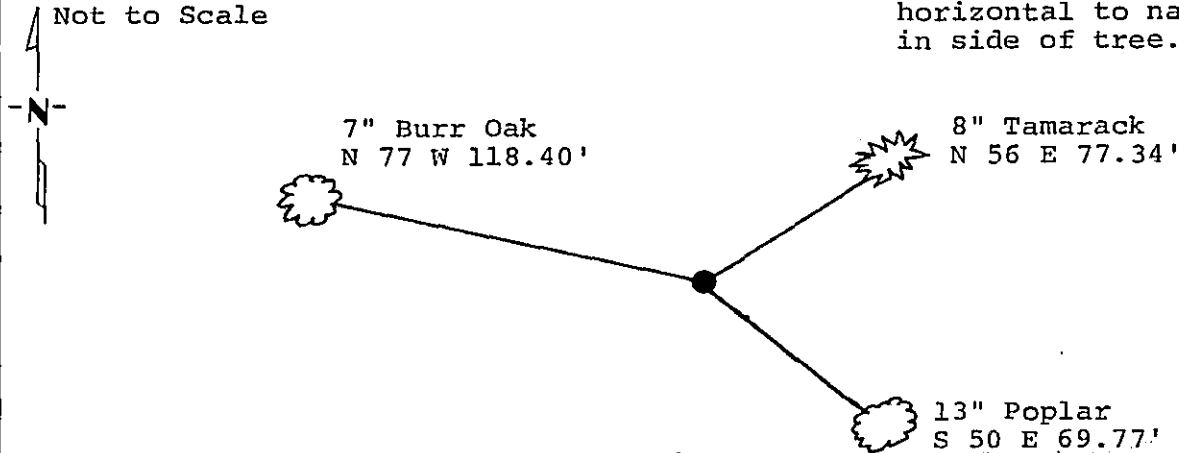

1873 P. H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, originally established this corner position while running the east line of Township 141 North, Range 29 West. The notes indicate a wood post was set to mark the corner position and the following witnesses: a 7 inch Tamarack North 42 and 1/2 degrees East a distance of 9 links; a 6 inch Tamarack North 19 degrees West a distance of 67 links; a 5 inch Tamarack North 53 degrees West a distance of 66 links; a 7 inch Tamarack North 61 degrees East a distance of 14 links.

1915 County Surveyor's Record Book C page 464 show survey by John Curo. He found old stake and evidence of the Northeast and Southeast bearing trees. He set a new stake.

1964 U.S. Forest Service records show the following: found decayed stumps of the Northeast and Northwest bearing trees and very old squared stake. Set a 2 inch by 60 inch iron pipe with a marked brass cap to mark this corner and marked the following witnesses: an 8 inch Aspen South 47 degrees East a distance of 70.0 feet; a 7 inch Aspen North 74 degrees West a distance of 78.0 feet; and a 7 inch Tamarack North 60 degrees east a distance of 77.3 feet.

1969 U.S. Forest Service Surveyor Bill Okerman filed corner certificate using 1964 information.

1986 U.S. Forest Service crews set an aerial target over this corner position for determination of coordinate values through the use of GPS on the Chippewa South Boundary Project Cadastral Survey U.S. Project Number 53-6392-8-219. This target allowed for the search and location of this corner.

1988 on May 18 a Landecker-Stevenson & Associates crew visited the corner and found the following evidence: 1965 Northeast and Southeast bearing trees; 2 inch Forest Service brass cap. New bearings trees were marked and steel sign posts found and set as noted on front of this certificate.
