

Statement of Evidence:

East Quarter Corner Section 13, Township 141
North, Range 31 West, Cass County, Minnesota

1873 P. H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, originally established this corner position while running the east township line of Township 141 North, Range 31 West. The notes indicate a wood post was set to mark the corner position and the following witnesses: a 14 inch Aspen South 72 degrees East a distance of 11 links; and an 8 inch Birch North 85 and 1/2 degrees West a distance of 5 links.

1918 U.S. General Land Office, while surveying the east line of Township 141 North, Range 31 West, did not find corner.

1988 on July 15 a Landecker-Stevenson & Associates crew searched for the corner and noted the following: that this corner position falls in centerline of North-South trail; that both original bearing tree positions fall in road; that no evidence of post or bearing trees; that a fence line runs East about 5 feet South of corner position.

1988 on September 20 a Landecker-Stevenson & Associates crew set a 2 inch by 24 inch iron pipe with brass cap and rerod in base, at the single proportional position between the northeast and southeast corners of said Section 13. 3 new bearing trees were marked as shown on front of this certificate and steel sign post is in place as shown.
