## Statement of Evidence:

Standard Southeast Corner Section 31, Township 141 North, Range 29 West, Cass County, Minnesota

1863 Johnson and Thornton, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, originally established this corner position while running the 10th Standard Parallel. The notes indicate a wood post was set to mark the corner position and the following witnesses: a 6 inch Tamarack North 5 degrees West a distance of 48 links; and a 5 inch Tamarack North 73 degrees East a distance of 12 links.

1964 U.S. Forest Service records show the following: technician Ekstrom searched for corner, but found no evidence of bearing trees.

1986 U.S. Forest Service crews set an aerial target in the vicinity of this corner for the search and establishment of the true corner position. The target having coordinate values through the use of GPS on the Chippewa South Boundary Project Cadastral Survey U.S. Project Number 53-6392-8-219. This target allowed for the search and location of this corner.

1988 on November 10 a Landecker-Stevenson & Associates crew searched for the corner. The following information was found and noted: no evidence of original 1863 Tamarack bearing trees or post.

1989 on January 28 a Landecker-Stevenson & Associates crew set a 2 inch by 48 inch iron pipe with brass cap, plastic base and magnet at the lost, single proportion position on the 10th Standard Parallel arc between the Southwest corner of Section 31 and the Southeast corner of Section 32. New bearing trees were marked as shown and a steel sign post is in place as noted on front of this certificate.
