

Statement of Evidence:

SMC on west 1/16 line, Section 9, T.141N., R.29W., 5th P.M.

- 1918 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner by setting a 1"x 36" with marked brass cap. The following bearing trees were marked: 8" Cedar N87-15E 60 lks, 10" Elm S48-15W 135 lks.
- 1987 On September 2, a Minnesota Department of Natural Resources survey crew found the GLO brass cap monument and possible 1918 B.T. 17" N87E 39', no scribe visible, but a scar. Corner location fits with other monuments found in the area.
- 1987 On September 8, Terry Freeman of the Cass County Surveyors Office visited corner with the same Department of Natural Resources crew. Placed 7' steel sign post with survey marker, sign 1' north and scribed the Department of Natural Resources B.T.'s (as shown on front) and placed "BT" tags on the trees.
