

1918 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner by setting a 1"x 36" I.P. with brass cap. The following bearing trees were marked: 9" White Oak N8-30E 61 lks., 7" White Oak S5-30W 42 lks.

1987 On September 2, a Minnesota Department of Natural Resources survey crew found the GLO brass cap monument flush with the ground in the center of an old trail and no sign of the 1918 B.T.'s. The location of this monument fits with other corners in the area. Three B.T.'s were marked.

19187 On September 8, Terry Freeman, Cass County Surveyors Office visited the corner with the same Department of Natural Resources survey crew. Placed a 7' steel sign post with "survey marker" sign east 5.0'. The Department of Natural Resources trees were scribed and "BT" tags placed on them.
