



1928 U.S. General Land Office resurvey set a 1" x 36" Iron Pipe with a stamped brass cap for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 5" Birch S 44-30 E 76 lks. (50.16') and a 6" Birch N 30-45 W 186 lks. ( 122.76' ).

1987 On January 7, Terry Freeman, Cass County Surveyors Office and Dennis Hummitzsch, County Forrester, found 1928 GLO brass cap and both 1928 B.T.'s: now a 13" Birch with scar S 54 E 50' and a 14" Birch with a scar N 40 W 123'. Left monument as found and marked two new B.T.'s as shown on the front of this certificate.
