

E-21

Northeast Corner, Section 11, T134N., R31W., 5th P.M.

- 1869 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 4" Aspen S34W 5 links, a 5" Aspen N65W 6 links, a 5" Aspen N35E 12 links, and a 4" Aspen S25E 10 links.
- 1915 County Survey Record Book "B", pages 484-495, shows a survey by N.D. Gorman. He started from the corner and ran north.
- 1915 County Survey Record Book "C", page 88, shows a survey by E.B. Horst. He found an iron monument and ran east.
- 1985 On November 1, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician found a 2" iron pipe down 0.1'.
- 1987 On August 5, they lowered the monument 10" and marked bearing trees as shown on the front of this certificate.
