- 1915 County Survey Record' Book "B", pages 484-485, show a survey by N.D. Gorman. He found the stump of the old government bearing tree which was a 14" Elm N31W 32 links.Notes show that possibly an iron monument was set.
- On November 4, Cass County Survey Technician Terry
  Freeman checked the County Highway Department's plans
  on County Road #34. Notes show that there was a deep
