



Statement of Evidence:

R-5

Northeast Corner, Section 30, T.134N., R.31W., 5th P.M.

- 1869 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: a 24" Aspen S55E 18 links, an 8" Aspen S32W 60 links, a 2" Aspen N52E 48 links, and a 14" Elm N31W 32 links.
- 1915 County Survey Record' Book "B", pages 484-485, show a survey by N.D. Gorman. He found the stump of the old government bearing tree which was a 14" Elm N31W 32 links. Notes show that possibly an iron monument was set.
- 1985 On November 4, Cass County Survey Technician Terry Freeman checked the County Highway Department's plans on County Road #34. Notes show that there was a deep cut in the area of the corner.
- 1986 On October 16, Terry Freeman placed a cast iron monument down 0.1' in the centerline of the east to west road in line with centerline of the roads north and south.
