

Northeast Corner Section 23, T 134 N, R 31 W, 5th P.M.

- 1869 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 14" Black Pine S 65 W, 8 Lks, 12" Black Pine N 35 E, 7 Lks, 6" Black Pine N 30 W, 28 Lks.
- 1908 County Survey Record Book "A", pages 52-53, show a survey by John Curo. He found SW, NE, and SE bearing trees. He set an 8"x8"x36" stone.
- 1986 On May 16, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician, and Glen Williams, backhoe operator, found an 8" square stone with the top broken off and down 1.7' with it's base in concrete. Terry Freeman marked the following bearings: power pole N 43 E, 48.12 feet, corner fence post N 50 W 46.03 feet and corner fence post S 57 E, 42.14 feet. Bearing tree tags were placed on corner fence posts, and an aluminum tag on the power pole.
- 1987 On August 6, Terry Freeman, drilled a hole in the rock and set an iron pipe $\frac{1}{2}$ "x13" in the rock. He also set a 1' piece of cast iron monument over it.
