East Quarter Corner, Section 25, T. 134N., R. 31W., 5th P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: a 10" Pitch Pine N45W 9 links and an 8" Pitch Pine S20E 14 links.
- On May 16, Cass County Survey Technician Terry Freeman and backhoe operator Glen Williams dug in the area of the north to south road and of the field line to the east. The area that they dug was 12' north to south by 8' east to west by a depth of 2'. They found a top of 0.25' then fill of 0.75'. They then dug into natural sandy-gravel of 1'.
- 1986 On September 17, Terry Freeman set a cast iron monument in the centerline of the north to south road in line with a field line to the east.
