

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER


North Quarter Corner of Section 11, Township 133N, Range 31W, 5th P.M.

At the corner location shown on the sketch:

- On 5/19/86 found a 2" iron pipe with top cut off lying down and

Statement of Evidence:

E - 19

North Quarter Corner, Section 11, T.133N., R.31W., 5th P.M.

- 1863 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: a 6" White Spruce S5W 9 links and a 7" White Spruce N76W 21 links.
- 1986 On May 19, Terry Freeman of the Cass County Surveyors Office and backhoe operator Glen Williams found a 2"x 32" iron pipe lying in road in intersection with part of it broken off. They also found a concrete base with a piece of anchor bolt in it that was down 3.7'. The following bearings were established: a Corner Fence Post S47W 45.68' and a PowerPole which is in line with the centerline of the road going west and 3' west of the centerline of the road that is going north to south.
- 1986 On October 28, a 2"x 18" telespar monument with an aluminum cap was placed down 1' and 3' west of the centerline of the road going north to south and in line with the centerline of the road going west.
