
At the corner location shown on the sketch:

Northeast Corner, Section 12, T.133N., R.32W., 5th P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 11" Pine N75 3/4E 45 links, 11" Pine N4 1/2 W 86 links, 6" Pine S46E 24 links, and a 5" Pine S24W 42 links.
- 1915 County Survey Record Book "B", pages 490-495, show a survey by N.P. Gorman. He found the corner.
- 1985 On October 29, Cass County Survey Technician Terry Freeman found a 1/2" iron rod at the east end of fence west.
- 1987 On October 22, Terry Freeman replaced rod with a 2" square telespar with a stamped aluminum cap. The cap was stamped "County Surveyor".
