


CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

At the corner location shown on the sketch:

- On 10/24/85 found a 3/4" x 12" iron pipe down 0.5' with the top bent to the southeast and a "BT" tag on a power pole to the northeast.
 left monument as found, lowered monument, removed monument (explain)
- On 8/11/87 placed a 2" x 18" telespar with a stamped aluminum cap down 8" in centerlines of roads east to west and going south.

Northeast Corner, Section 24, T.133N., R.31W., 5th P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: a 10" Pine S34E 13 links, a 12" Pine N68W 14 links, a 7" Pine N20E 25 links, and a 7" Pine S36W 25 links.
- 1972 Dean Anderson, Land Surveyor, platted "Castle Addition To Bigwater". The plat that he did, showed the corner.
- 1985 On October 24, Cass County Survey Technician Terry Freeman found a 3/4" x 12" iron pipe down 0.5' and bent to the southeast. He also found a "BT" tag on a power pole located to the northeast.
- 1987 On August 11, Terry Freeman placed a 2" x 18" telespar monument with a stamped aluminum cap down 8" in the centerlines of the east to west road and the road that intersects it going south.
