



Statement of Evidence:

T-17

East Quarter Corner, Section 27, T.134N., R.31W., 5th P.M.

- 1869 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: a 6" Tamarack N75E 18 links and a 6" Spruce S82W 14 links.
- 1986 On May 16, Terry Freeman of the Cass County Surveyors Office and backhoe operator dug in the area of the north to south road and fence east. They dug an area 12' north to south by 8' east to west by 2' deep. The first 6" was top and fill and then they dug 1.5' into natural sand and gravel.
- 1986 On September 18, Terry Freeman and Norman Morris replaced a car spring that was found with a cast iron monument. It was placed down 10" and 3.5' west of the centerline of the north to south road and 8' north of the old fence to the east of the road.
