

Northeast Corner, Section 32, T.134N., R.31W., 5th P.M.

- 1869 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: a 6" Spruce N27W 12 links, an 18" Spruce N60E 24 links, a 10" Aspen S31E 47 links, and a 4" Tamarack S34W 37 links.
- 1915 County Survey Record Book "B", pages 484-495, show a survey by N.D. Gorman. He set the corner proportionally. The notes show that an iron monument was possibly set.
- 1985 On October 30, Cass County Survey Technician Terry Freeman talked to Jim Ackerson, resident in Section 33. He said that an iron monument had been bladed out.
- 1986 On September 30, Terry Freeman placed a cast iron monument in the centerline of the road going north to south in line with the road going west and 6' north of the trail going east. It was placed down 6".
