


1/4 Cor. 2 and 35 (N 1/4 Cor. Sec. 2)

1872 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for corner and the following references were noted:
Spruce 4" S 3 degrees E, 23 Links (15.18 feet)
Spruce 5" N 25 degrees W, 15 Links (9.90 feet)

10-25-1989 Personnel from Kovanen & Osufsen Inc. search area, find old rusted tag on 3" Cedar N 25 degrees W, 13' from our lost position, also old post, not GLO, with rusted tag North 6', Approx. 100' West and 50' North we find brush lines (DNR) to North and West 10 to 15 years old. We set a 2" x 48" brass capped monument in lost position and the following witnesses:
Cedar 6" S 52 degrees W, 14.04 feet
Spruce 3" N 60 degrees W, 17.16 feet
Spruce 3" N 10 degrees W, 9.43 feet
Set 8' long steel sign post with sign attached, West 5.6 feet

This position is not traceable to the original GLO corner, but accepted as corner for lack of further evidence.
