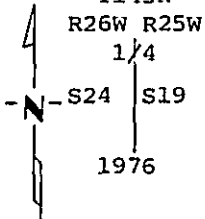

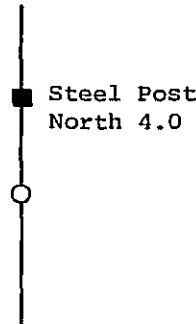

P25 East quarter corner section 24

1/4 Cor. 24 and 19 (E 1/4 Cor. Sec. 24)

- 1872 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for corner and the following references were noted:  
Tamarack 6" N 15 degrees 30 minutes E, 6 Links (3.96 feet)  
Cedar 6" N 37 degrees W, 4 Links (2.64 feet)
- 4-6-1966 James Ekstrom, USFS, chained to area from approximate section corner to north, area under snow and water, more search needed.
- 7-25-1966 James Ekstrom, USFS, did additional search, found no evidence.
- 1976 BLM dependent resurvey, found no original evidence, at proportionate distance they set a 2.5"x 28" aluminum post with an aluminum cap and witnessed as follows:  
Cedar 8" N 40 degrees W, 17.5 Links (11.55 feet)  
Cedar 6" N 46 degrees E, 21 Links (13.86 feet)
- 10-27-1989 Personnel from Kovanen & Osufsen Inc. found 1976 BLM monument in good condition and the following witnesses:  
Cedar 8" N 40 degrees W, 11.60 feet  
Cedar 6" N 46 degrees E, 13.97 feet  
we add the following witness:  
Cedar 4" S 71 degrees E, 20.49 feet  
Steel sign post with sign attached, North, 4.0

This position is not traceable to the original GLO corner, but accepted as corner for lack of further evidence.
