

1872 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for corner and the following references were noted:
Sugar Maple 14" N 11 degrees E, 22 Links (14.52 feet)
Balsam 10" S 45 degrees E, 11 Links (7.26 feet)
Sugar Maple 8" S 25 degrees W, 20 Links (13.20 feet)
Elm 16" N 59 degrees W, 15 Links (9.90 feet)

7-25-1966 James Ekstrom, USFS, found no evidence of corner.

1976 BLM dependent resurvey, found no original evidence, at proportionate distance they set a 2.5"x 28" aluminum post with an aluminum cap and witnessed as follows:
Aspen 10" N 8 degrees E, 10.5 Links (6.93 feet)
Aspen 14" S 76 degrees E, 12.5 Links (8.25 feet)
Aspen 10" S 20 degrees W, 29 Links (19.14 feet)
Aspen 14" N 72 degrees W, 41.5 Links (27.39 feet)

11-1-1989 Personnel from Kovanen & Osufsen Inc. found 1976 BLM monument in good condition and the following witnesses, to which we add 30d spikes:
Aspen 10" N 7 degrees E, 7.08 feet
Aspen 12" S 68 degrees E, 14.00 feet
Aspen 9" S 20 degrees W, 18.63 feet
Aspen 18" N 70 degrees W, 27.13 feet
8' long steel sign post with sign attached, South, 3.5 feet.

This position is not traceable to the original GLO corner, but accepted as corner for lack of further evidence.
