

# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER


Northeast Corner of Section 34, Township 134N., Range 31W., 5th P.M.

- On 5/19/86 found an 8"x8" stone, 14" long w/top broke off, base

Statement of Evidence:

V-17

Northeast Corner, Section 34, T.134N., R.31W., 5th P.M.

- 1869 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 4" Aspen N10W 12 links, 10" Aspen N48E 25 links, 8" Aspen S80W 60 links, and a 16" Aspen S65E 40 links.
- 1907 County Survey Record Book "A", pages 30-31, show a survey by John Curo. He found the old government bearing tree: a 10" Aspen N48E 16.5'. He set an 8" x 8" x 36" stone in concrete.
- 1986 On May 19, Terry Freeman, Cass County Surveyors Office, and backhoe operator Glen Williams found an 8" square stone with the top broke off down 1.5'. Its base was in concrete. They found the top part of the stone behind a corner fence post and southeast of the corner. The corner is 2' east of the centerline of the north to south road and 6' south of the centerline of the east to west road. They marked the following bearings: a Corner Fence Post S35E 32.45' and a Power Pole N30E 49.8'. Other bearing trees are shown on the front of this certificate.
