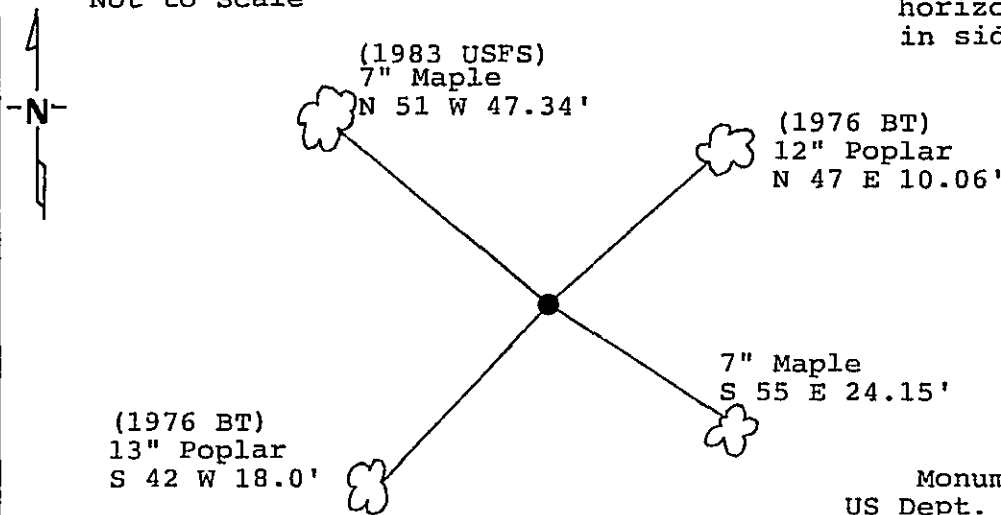

1871 Walker, Putnam and Allen, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, originally established this corner position while running the line between Townships 142 and 143 North, Range 25 West. The notes indicate a wood post was set to mark the corner position and the following witnesses: a 6 inch Maple North 62 degrees East a distance of 11 links; and an 8 inch Fir South 34 degrees West a distance of 16 links.

1976 Bureau of Land Management dependent resurvey reestablished this corner at the single proportionate position between the Meander corner on the West side of Willow Lake and the North Quarter corner of Section 4. A 2 and 1/2 inch by 28 inch aluminum pipe with an aluminum cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: a 12 inch Aspen North 42 degrees East a distance of 15 links (9.9 feet); and a 12 inch Aspen South 45 degrees West a distance of 27 links (17.82 feet).

1979 Gary Stevenson & Associates, Inc., survey crew found the 1976 Bureau of Land Management monuments around Section 34, Township 143 North, Range 25 West. They were used to subdivide said section.

1983 U.S. Forest Service personnel found the 1976 Bureau of Land Management 2 and 1/2 inch capped aluminum post and both 1976 Aspen bearing trees. They marked a 6 inch Maple bearing tree North 51 degrees West a distance of 47.34 feet and set a steel sign post West 3.0 feet.

1990 on October 26, a Landecker & Associates, Inc., survey crew found the 2 and 1/2 inch aluminum capped monument 8 inches above ground as set by the Bureau of Land Management in 1976. Bearing trees are marked as shown and a steel sign post was set as noted on front of this certificate.
