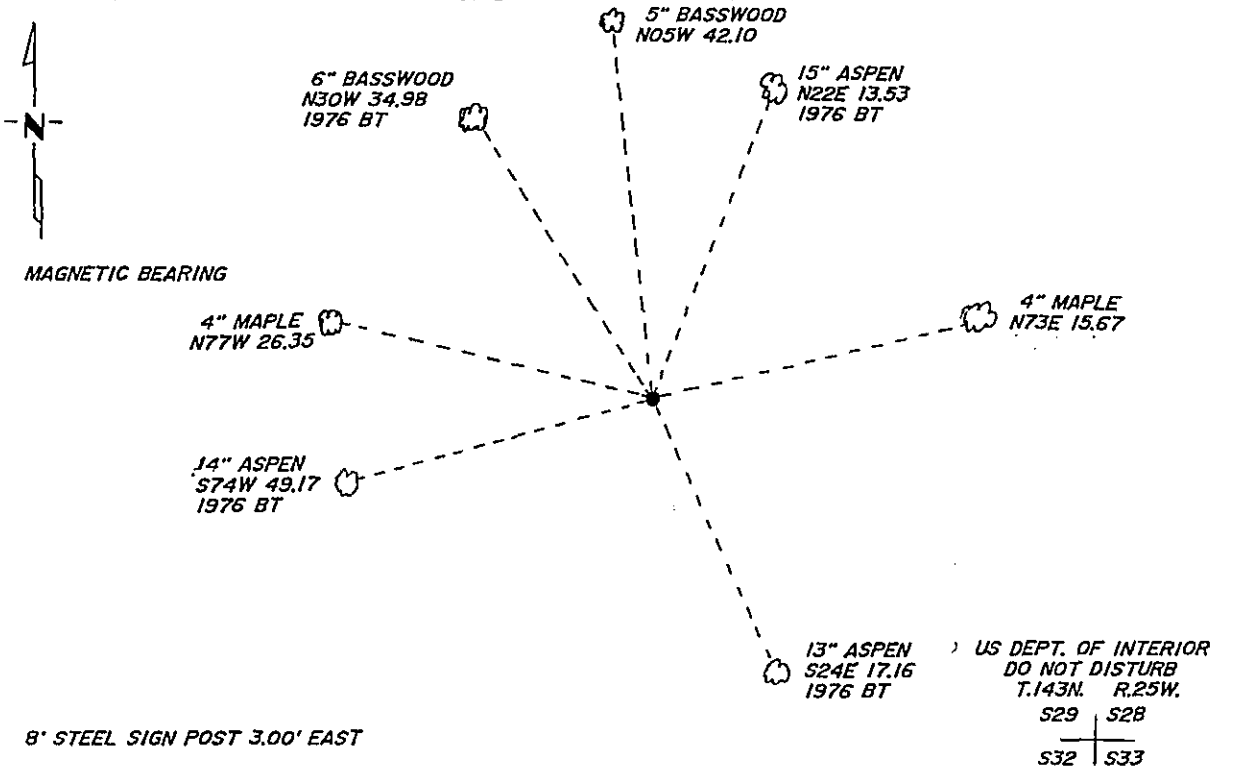

V-9 NE Cor. of Sec. 32, T. 143 N., R. 25 W.

1872 Original survey by Hayward and Griffin, set a wood post and marked bt's as follows;

8" Birch	N61E	18 lks
10" Birch	N11W	14 lks
8" Balsam	S22W	20 lks
8" Sugar	S58E	13 lks

1924 J.H. Flynn, in making a road survey found the NE, NW, and SE bt's and set a 1" iron pipe monument. recorded in county survey record book D, page 132.

1963 USFS made a search for this corner. Book 1, page 9.

1976 B.L.M. made a dependent resurvey of part of the township and found a 1" pipe and set a 2 1/2" x 28" aluminum pipe with cap in place of the 1" pipe. They marked bt's as follows;

15" Aspen	N22E	20 1/2 lks
13" Aspen	S24E	26 lks
14" Aspen	S74W	74 1/2 lks
6" basswood	N30W	53 lks

1989 The USFS used this monument in a traverse around section 28.

1989 Walt Curo found the B.L.M. monument in good condition and accept the B.L.M. monument as being traceable to original position.
