Statement of Evidence:

U-13 S 1/16 Cor. of Sec. 27-28, T. 143 N., R. 25 W.

- 1976 B.L.M. made a dependant resurvey of part of the township and found a 1" pipe of unknown origin and set a 2 1/2" × 28" alumnium pipe with cap in place of the 1" pipe for the northeast corner of sec. 28. From this point they go south on record bearing, the record distance and set a monument.
- 1979-1983 B.L.M. was made aware of a 1900 survey by the Corp. of engineers which gave a new position for the NE corner of the section. B.L.M. then made a corrective dependent resurvey and made a new determination of the section line. They moved the monument to a newly computed position on this line.
- 1989 The USFS used this monument as part of a traverse around section 28.
- 1990 Walt Curo accepts the B.L.M. monument for the corner as this position was monumented and accepted by B.L.M. as the true position for this corner.
