1873 P.H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, originally established this corner position while running the north line of Township 141 North, Range 31 West. The notes indicate a wood post was set to mark the corner position and the following witnesses: a 4 inch Poplar North 13 degrees West a distance of 13 links; and a 3 inch Birch South 27 degrees East a distance of 7 links.

1916-1917 County Surveyor's Record Book C, page 125, shows survey by E.B. Horst. The notes indicate an iron monumnet was set proportionally. The survey was signed by John Curo, Cass County Surveyor. The notes do not indicate that any bearing trees were marked.

1962 Licensed Land Surveyor, Pete Meyer, filed certificate of location of Government corner. He found the 2 inch by 48 inch iron pipe as set by County Surveyor, John Curo, in 1916.

1978 Milo Stefan, Licensed Land Surveyor Number 12261, also the United States Forest Service surveyor, plats U.S. Government land in Section 6. The notes indicate he set the quarter corner lost at the single proportion posotion and makes note that the 1962 affidavit by Meyer is void. The 1962 monument was 300 feet, more or less, north of the single proportion position.

1991 Landecker & Associates, Inc. survey crew finds brass cap monument as set by Stefan in 1978. They find the 1978 bearing trees and steel sign posts and mark one new bearing tree as shown on front of this certificate. Landecker & Associates, Inc. accepts the brass cap as monumented by Stefan in 1978 as marking the lost location of the corner.
