



Statement of Evidence:

The Northeast Corner of Section 18, Township 134, Range 32, 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota, was set in 1870 under the Public Land Survey as a post with 2 bearing trees. No evidence of the post or bearing trees was found.

A search of County records revealed no additional data.

In 1991 and 1992, while subdividing Section 7-134-32, Thomas P. Thiessen, RLS No. 16097, searched in the area of the Northeast Corner of Section 18, in the swamp using the swamp calls from the Government Notes. No corner was found. On March 22, 1992, a 1/2" iron pipe capped RLS No. 16097 was placed at the obliterated position using the swamp calls. A check of distance north, east, south and west verifies this as the position of the Northeast Corner of Section 18.
