Statement of Evidence:

The Northeast Corner of Section 7, Township 134, Range 32, 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota, was set under the Public Land Survey, in 1870, as a post with 2 bearing trees. No evidence of the post or bearing trees was found.

A search of County Records revealed no additional data.

In 1991 and 1992, while subdividing Section 7, Thomas P. Thiessen, RLS No. 16097, found an intersection of a east-west and north-south fence line at the position for the Northeast Corner of Section 7. A check of distances north, south, east and west fits well. On Dec. 24, 1991, a 1/2 inch iron pipe capped RLS No. 16097, was placed at the fence lines intersection and is accepted as the position for the Northeast Corner of Section 7.
