1868 The U.S. General Land Office field notes, on file in the Secretary of State's Office, show this corner to be marked with a post and marked the following bearing trees:

W. Pine 36" N 18° W 12 lks., W. Pine 36" S 48° W 33 lks. W. Pine 24" S 48° E 49 lks., W. Pine 30" N 21° E 77 lks.

1911 Cass County Land Corner Record Card, on file in the County Surveyor's Office, shows in County Survey Record Book A, on Pages 465 to 472, A.W. Moulstor found a 1 1/4" iron pipe "set by state surveyor from old Gov't BT Stumps": Burned Pine Stump N 7° 30' W 7.75 ft., Burned Pine Stump N 20° E 50.60 ft., Burned Pine Stump S 47° W 21.30 ft., Burned Pine Stump S 48° 30' E 32.30 ft. Both north stumps marked B.T. Piled rocks around pipe and located a little pot hole S 75° W 80 ft. This information is also on microfilm - roll 105 Book 50 Page 56.

July, the DNR Bureau of Engineering conducted a search for this corner and found the following: a 1 1/4" iron pipe up 0.4 ft. with 10" - 12' stones piled around it, two (2) 1 1/4" iron pipes sloping away from the first pipe at a 45° angle down, one to the north, the other to the west. Searched for but did not find any evidence of the government bearing trees. The first iron pipe was found to measure:

2651.40 ft. from the east quarter corner Section 10 2644.99 ft. from the north quarter corner Section 14

Analysis of the available information led the DNR Bureau of Engineering to conclude that the found iron pipe up 0.4 ft. marks the location of the corner. Its origin can be traced back to the government bearing trees.
