

**North Quarter Corner Section 11, Township 143 North, Range 25 West**

The DNR Bureau of Engineering contacted the following offices for information on this corner:

MN Secretary of State  
Itasca County Surveyor  
Cass County Surveyor  
Landecker and Associates at Walker

- 1872 The U.S. General Land Office field notes, on file in the Secretary of State's Office, describe this corner as a post with the following bearing trees:  
Tamarack 4" S 44° E 20 links, Ash 5" N 40° E 50 links
- 1914 County Book C, on file in the Cass County Surveyor's Office, contains a survey by F.A. Donner. A 4"x4"x8" wood post was set at this corner proportionately and two reference ties are shown.
- 1966 A section subdivision worksheet, obtained from Landecker and Associates, signed by R. F. Schneider, RLS #5743, shows this corner as a standard monument. Three reference ties are shown on the worksheet. The corner is shown to measure:  
2633.45 ft from adjoining section corners
- 1977 Cass County Highway Department found an I.M. in place at the corner, a DNR property corner.
- 1995 August 15, the DNR Bureau of Engineering conducted a search for this corner and found a standard DNR monument, vintage 1960's labeled conservation monument. Search for reference ties, but found nothing. The corner was found to measure:  
2632.26 ft. from the northwest corner Section 11  
2633.49 ft. from the northeast corner Section 11

Analysis of the available information led the DNR Bureau of Engineering to conclude that the found DNR conservation monument marks the location of the corner.
