The original public land survey was run in 1870 and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

On June 27, 1967, Mr Dean Anderson set the corner and established ties to two birch trees and a power pole.

On June 16, 1999, The Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered a 0.5 inch iron pipe with R.L.S. cap number 3091. Bearing ties were made to a power pole, a wooden fence post, and an oak tree. The Minnesota Department of Transportation accepts this position as the correct location for the corner.
