



**Statement of Evidence:**

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 138 NORTH,  
RANGE 32 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

The original Public Land Survey was run by Mahlon Black in 1870. A post was set to mark the corner and two bearing trees were recorded as accessories; a 6- inch Balsam South 41 degrees West 53 links, and a 10- inch Spruce North 10 degrees East 69 links.

In 1996 the Minnesota Department of Transportation conducted an intensive search for additional document, physical and parole evidence for this corner. None could be found.

Analysis of the above information indicates that this Public Land Survey corner is lost. May 27, 1997 a cast iron monument was placed in lost position to mark this corner; a single proportion measurement between the northeast and northwest corners of Section 10.
