## Statement of Evidence:

## NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 138 NORTH, RANGE 32 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

The original Public Land Survey was run by Mahlon Black in 1870. A post was set to mark the corner and four bearing trees were recorded as accessories; a 9-inch Tamarack North  $46\frac{1}{2}$  degrees East 32 links, a 7-inch Tamarack North  $15\frac{1}{2}$  degrees West 33 links, a 9-inch Tamarack South 48 degrees East 12 links, and a 5-inch Tamarack South 6 degrees West 6 links.

In 1912, John Curo recovered the post and bearing trees recorded by Black in 1870. A concrete monument measuring 8 inches square and 36 inches long was placed to mark this corner.

On October 14, 1993, Todd Larson and Richard Hilliard of the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered the concrete monument placed by Curo in 1912 to mark this corner.

The location of this Public Land Survey Corner has been perpetuated by the recovery of the post and placement of the concrete monument by Curo in 1912 and recovery of the concrete monument by Larson and Hilliard in 1993. A  $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch iron pin was placed above the concrete monument to mark this corner.
