

Northeast corner, Section 22, Township 134 North, Range 30 West,
Cass County, Minnesota.

1868

Nathan Butler originally established this corner position while subdividing Township 134 North, Range 30 West. A wood post was set to mark the corner with the following witnesses: A 28" Pine, North 84 1/2 degrees East, 84 links; a 28" Pine, North 57 1/4 degrees East, 98 links; a 30" Pine, North 39 degrees West, 164 links.

1996

Landedecker and Associates, Inc. searched for and found no evidence of the corner. Established this corner by double proportion method using monuments found and accepted as the following section corners: the Northwest Corner of Section 22, the Northwest Corner of Section 14, the North 1/4 Corner of Section 23, and the West 1/4 Corner of Section 26, all in Township 134 North, Range 30 West.

2003

Landecker and Associates, Inc. verified corner position and set 1/2" iron pipe with plastic cap stamped "17008" as perpetuation of the original corner. Established the following witnesses: A 6" Birch, North 60 degrees West, 150.59 feet; a 8" Oak, North 50 degrees East, 69.03 feet; a 10" Birch, South 14 degrees West, 208.33 feet.
