



Statement of Evidence

East 1/4, Section 6, T. 133N. R. 31W., 5th P.M.

The original Land Survey was run in 1863 by George W. Wright and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1985 Terry Freeman excavated and found nothing.

In 1987 Comstock and Davis Inc. did a survey for Ira Allen dated Jan. 22, 1987, Job #LF86071 and computed a proportioned lost position on centerline. It appears as though nothing was set.

In 1997 Central Minnesota Surveying did a survey for Bill Skeesick dated May 30, 1997, Job #975837 and set a 1/2" pipe capped 17253 at Comstock and Davis' computed position.

In 2003 Westwood Professional Services found a 1/2" pipe capped 17253 ties to which are as shown on the front of this page.
