

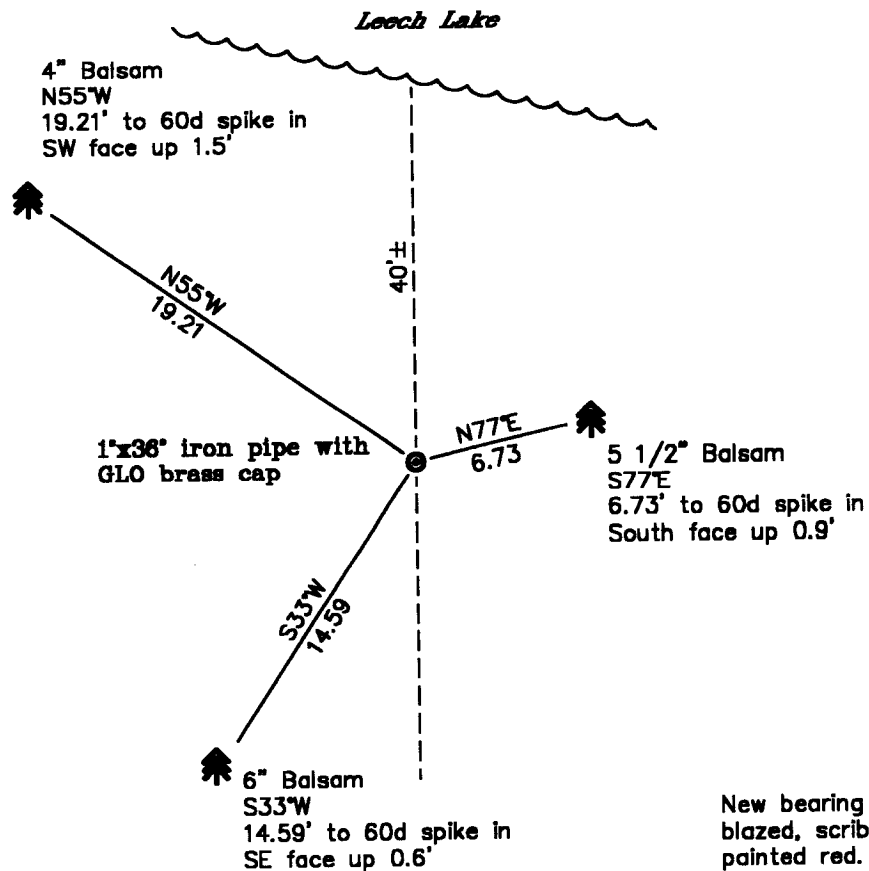
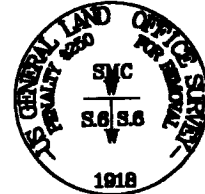
CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

Special Meander Corner on West 1/16 line between Government Lot 2 and Government Lot 12, Section 6, Township 141 North, Range 29 West, of the 5th Principal Meridian. This corner, a 1" x 36" iron pipe with brass cap, is accepted as the original SMC set by the GLO Resurvey in 1918.

Bearings are Grid North, Minnesota Central Zone, measured with a hand compass adjusted to 3° East declination.

New bearing trees were blazed, scribed and painted red. A location tag was affixed to the tree. A 60 d spike was placed in the tree. The horizontal distance was measured from the monument to the spike.

September 23, 2003: J. Major and B. Thompson of Northern Lights Surveying & Mapping found the GLO 1" X 36" iron pipe with brass cap tipped slightly. They found no evidence of the bearing trees. The monument was straightened and witnessed with the following bearing trees:
