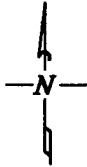


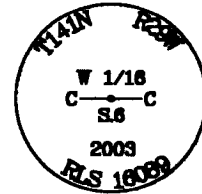
### CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

Center West 1/16th Corner, Section 6, Township 141 North, Range 29 West, of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota. Broken 1" iron pipe is accepted as originally set by the GLO resurvey of 1918. The broken pipe was replaced with a 4' x 2 1/2" galvanized steel pipe with a 3 1/4" stamped bronze cap.

1918: Earl G. Harrington, US Surveyor, set a 1"x36" iron pipe with a brass cap from which he made the following BT's:

Notes of G.L.O. Resurvey of 1917, Page 182. Said notes are on file with the Secretary of State, Saint Paul, MN. Copies of these notes can be found at the Cass County Surveyor's Office in Walker, MN.

February 2, 2000: R. Main, United States Forest Service, found the G.L.O. iron in place. The cap and 4" of pipe are broke off at ground level. He found and made the following BT's: USFS Book 6, Page 67.

September, 2003: Northern Lights Surveying and Mapping, found the iron in place and the cap near by. Found BT's from 2000. Replaced the G.L.O. monument with a 4' x 2 1/2" Galvanized Steel Pipe with a 3 1/4" bronze stamped cap. Made one new BT and added signs as follows. All BT's are painted and have tags.
