

Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner of Section 11, Township 133 North, Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota.

The original Government Survey was run in 1863, by Mr. George B. Wright, Deputy Surveyor, and a wood post was set, with two Black Oak Bearing Trees as accessories.

In July, 1912, John Curo, Cass County Surveyor, set a hub and tack from the original Black Oak Bearing Trees, County Survey Record Book A, Pages 496-498.

In August, 1994, Mr. John W. Hanson, Minnesota Registration Number 14712, set a ½ inch iron pipe on the centerline of a North-South road, and in line with an old fence remnant West. This location is approximately 6 feet East and 5 feet North of a lost position.

On December 3, 2004, Mr. Kevin J. Metz, Minnesota Registration Number 40343, found a ½ inch iron pipe, with an unreadable R.L.S. cap, as described by Mr. Hanson. New ties were taken at this time, as shown on the front of this document. I accept this position as the correct location for the Corner.
