## Statement of Evidence:

East Quarter Corner Section 4, Township 140 North, Range 30 West

The Original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner. Bearing tree ties were made to a Norway Pine and a White Ash.

In 1978 the Cass County Highway Department recovered a 1" iron pipe monument.

Mr. Stevenson recovered a 1 ½" iron pipe monument. Bearing tree ties were made to a Power Pole, a White Pine and a Twin White Oak.

In February 2004, Kramer Leas DeLeo shows a PK nail recovered on a certificate of survey.

In March 2004, Kramer Leas DeLeo shows a PK nail recovered on a certificate of survey.
