

Statement of Evidence:

Northeast Corner Section 12, Township 134 North, Range 30 West

The Original Public Land Survey was run in 1858 and a wood post was set to mark the corner. Bearing tree ties were made to four White Pines.

In 1914 Mr. John Curo recovered a 2" iron pipe and stumps from all four White Pines used as bearing trees in the Original Public Land Survey. Bearing tree ties were made to a Norway Pine, Jack Pine and a Poplar.

In 1966 the Cass County Highway Department recovered an iron pipe monument.

In 1966 Mr. Dean Anderson set a Cass County cast iron monument flush with the ground. Bearing tree ties were made to a White Pine, Norway Pine and a White Oak.

In 1990 the Cass County Highway Department recovered an iron pipe monument.

In 2003 the Cass County Survey Office recovered a telespar monument with an aluminum cap flush with the ground. 29 feet north of centerline of County Road #15 and 43 feet east of centerline of County Road #107. Bearing tree ties were made to two White Pines, and an Ash.

In 2004 Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a telespar monument in place and made bearing tree ties to three White Pines. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this position as the correct location for the corner.
