

Statement of Evidence:

Northeast Corner Section 29, Township 137 North, Range 29 West

The Original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner. Bearing tree ties were made to two Norway Pines and a Black Pine.

In 1910 Mr. John Curo recovered an iron pipe set from old Government bearing trees and placed a concrete post. Bearing tree ties were made to two Jack Pines.

In 1915 Mr. John Curo recovered a concrete monument.

A 2" by 48" iron pipe is mentioned on the corner card, but it is unknown whether it was found or set.

In 1922 Mr. C.J. Bark placed a 6" square concrete monument. Bearing ties were made to four iron pipes.

In 2004 Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a 1" iron pipe monument. Bearing tree ties were made to a corner fence post, the northwest corner of Wilson Town Hall and an Oak Tree. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this position as the correct location for the corner.
