

Statement of Evidence: Northeast corner Section 14, Township 133 North, Range 31 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1863 and a wood post was set to mark the corner. Bearing tree ties were made to a birch tree, two white oaks, and a spruce tree.

In 1912 Mr. John Curo set a 2.5" by 36" iron pipe monument in concrete. Bearing tree ties were made to two oak stumps and an oak tree.

In 1953 the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered an iron pipe monument and set a galvanized iron pipe monument. Bearing tree ties were made to an iron monument.

In 1985 Mr. Terry Freeman recovered an iron pipe monument. Bearing tree ties were recovered from 1953 State Highway Department ties.

In 2006 Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a telspar monument with a stamped aluminum cap. Bearing tree ties were made to two power poles, a fence corner, and a utility pedestal. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
