

Statement of Evidence: East Quarter corner of Section 28, Township 140, Range 29 West, 5th Principle Meridian, Cass County Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1870 and a post was set to mark the corner. Bearing tree ties were made to a White Pine.

In 1968, Mr. R.F. Schneider set a 2 ½ inch iron pipe to mark the corner by lost methods. Bearing ties were made to a White Pine, a White Oak, and a Red Oak.

In 2002, Mr. R. Mustonen, indicates iron monument found by Certificate of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records. Bearing tree ties were made to a White Pine, a White Oak, and an Ash.

In 2005 Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a 2 inch iron pipe. Bearing ties were made to a "T-post", an Ash, a White Pine, and an Oak tree. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
