

Statement of Evidence: Northeast corner of Section 18, Township 142, Range 30 West, 5th Principle Meridian, Cass County Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1918 and a 2 x 36 inch Iron Pipe Monument with a brass cap was set to mark the corner. Bearing ties were set to two Oaks, a Willow and an Elm.

In 1970, Mr. William Okerman recovered the GLO monument in good condition. Bearing ties were set to 3 Oaks, and an Elm.

In 2006 Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a 2" pipe with a stamped brass cap and recovered ties to two Oak trees. Additional ties were made to an ironwood tree and an oak tree. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
