

**Statement of Evidence:** East Quarter corner of Section 28, Township 137, Range 29 West, 5<sup>th</sup> Principle Meridian, Cass County Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1865 and a post was set to mark the corner. Bearing ties were set to a Black Pine and a Norway Pine tree.

In 1908, Mr. John Curo, set a 7/8 inch iron proportionally, as recorded in Cass County Survey Record Book "A", pg. 318-328.

In 1998, Landecker, RLS #17008, indicates monument found by Certificates of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

In October 2003, P. Trottier, RLS #41002, indicates monument found by Certificates of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

In June of 2006, Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a 1/2" iron pipe monument and made bearing tree ties to a cottonwood, a power pole, and a norway pine. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
