

Statement of Evidence: North Quarter Corner of Section 33, Township 137, Range 29 West, 5th Principle Meridian, Cass County Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1865 and a post was set to mark the corner. Bearing ties were set to an Aspen and a Tamarack tree.

In 1998, the Cass County Surveyors Office recovered, in place, a 2 inch aluminum capped monument down 0.3 inches in the bituminous 1.2' north of the centerline of Co Rd. 115. The top was marred and unreadable. Bearing ties were set to a Burr Oak, two Red Oaks, and a fence pole.

In 2002, the Cass County Surveyors Office, in a corner GPS, recovered the aluminum capped pipe down 0.2 inches on centerline.

In June of 2006 Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a telspar monument and made bearing tree ties to a red oak, a burr oak and a corner fence post. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
