

Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner of Section 2, Township 133, Range 32 West, 5th Principle Meridian, Cass County Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1863 and a post was set to mark the corner. Bearing ties were made to two Tamarack trees.

In 2000, Mr. Ron Eldevik indicates monument found by Certificate of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

In 2003, Mr. Bruce Grivna indicates monument found by Certificate of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

In 2005, Mr. Ron Eldevik indicates monument found by Certificate of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

On June 20, 2006, Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a Telspar monument and bearing tree ties were made to three tamarac trees. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
