

Statement of Evidence: Northeast Corner of Section 12, Township 133, Range 32 West, 5th Principle Meridian, Cass County Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1858 and a post was set to mark the corner. Bearing ties were made to four Pine trees.

In 1915, Mr. N.D. Gorman recovered the corner as recorded in County Book "B", pg. 490-495.

In 1985, Mr. Terry Freeman recovered the corner and set a 2 x 2 x 36 inch Telespar Monument. Bearing ties were made to a Jack Pine, a Burr Oak, a Power Pole, and an Oak Fence Post.

In 1989 and in 1990, Mr. Walter Curo indicates monument found by Certificates of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

On June 20, 2006, Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a Telspar Monument. Three existing bearing trees were recovered. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
