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

Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner of Section 31, Township 136, Range 29 West, 5th Principle Meridian, Cass County Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1870 and a post was set to mark the corner. Bearing ties were made to Pine trees.

In 1909 Mr. John Curo set a temporary corner as indicated in Cass County Survey Record Book A, pg. 571-575. Bearing ties were set to a Fence Post and an old stump.

In February of 1991, Mr. David Landecker, RLS #17008, recovered the corner and set a ½ inch capped iron pipe 2 inches below the road surface. Bearing ties were set to a Jackpine tree, a telephone pedestal, and a Poplar tree.

In March of 1992, Mr. David Landecker, RLS #17008, indicates monument found by Certificate of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

In February of 2001, the Cass County Surveyor's Office recovered the corner. Bearing ties were set to a Red Oak, a Telephone Pole, and Power Pole, and a Red Pine.

In 2003, Mr. P. Trottier, RLS #41002, indicates monument found by Certificate of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

In March of 2004, Mr. P. Trottier, RLS #41002, indicates monument found by Certificate of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

In November of 2004, Mr. P. Trottier, RLS #41002, indicates monument found by Certificate of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

In September of 2006, Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a ½" iron pipe monument. Existing bearing tree ties were found on a power pole and a telephone pedestal. An additional ties was made to a burr oak. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
