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East Quarter Corner, Section 4, Township 145 North, Range 31 West, Fifth Principal Meridian

1875

B.C. Baldwin, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, originally established this corner position while surveying the interior subdivision lines of Township 145 North, Range 31 West. A wood post was set to mark the corner position with the following witnesses: An 8 inch Jack Pine, North 89 degrees East, 40 links; An 8 inch Jack Pine, North 73 degrees West, 99 links.

While running the line North between Section 3 and 4, he terminates the line at Drewery Lake and does not close on the north township line.

Copies of the above record are on file at the Cass County Survey Office.

1900-1904

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers survey map of the Lake Winnibigoshish Reservoir on file with the U.S. Forest Service in Cass Lake indicates that no corner was recovered.

1922

E.B. Horst, LS#376, on Microfilm Roll 12, Curo Book 186, Page 5 shows a traverse along the west and north lines of Section 3. Survey indicates a position established for this corner.
