

- 1870 U.S. General Land Office notes obtained from the Secretary of State's Office states that a post was set to mark the comer midway between the section corners 39.60 chains (2613.6') each way with the following bearing trees marked:
W. Pine 8" N 64° E 9links (5.94 feet)
W. Birch S 14° E 28 links (18.48 feet)
- 2006 In July, the DNR survey crew searched for evidence of the comer and found nothing. Arro Surveying of Walker is doing a survey in Section 5, so we will wait until they are done, as they need the East and Southeast corners of section 5.
- 2007 In January, received word that Bruce Skipton at Arro Surveying had finished his survey. In March, the DNR survey crew set a 3/4" iron rod with survey cap stamped "MN DNR LS 16098" at a lost position between the Southeast and Southwest comers of section 4.
- Southwest Comer Section 4 bears S 87°33'35"W 2616.58'
Southeast Comer Section 4 bears N 87°33'35"E 2616.58'
